The International Dyslexia Association (IDA) is a non-profit, charitable organization that concerns itself with the complex issues of dyslexia. The mission of IDA Ontario is to promote literacy through research, education, and advocacy for dyslexic individuals and their families in Ontario. We believe that **learning to read is a right**, not a privilege and that **all individuals have the right to achieve their potential**.

Due to the expansion and growth of IDA Ontario a number of opportunities have opened up at board level (volunteer capacity). This is your chance to help ensure that individuals with a language learning difficulty have the opportunity to lead a productive and fulfilling life.

Individual Board Members' Responsibilities

As a board member you will have the following responsibilities:

- Attend all board meetings (approximately five a year) and functions such as special events
- Make a serious commitment to participate actively on committees or task forces, to include acting as chair where necessary
- Review agenda and supporting materials prior to board and committee meetings
- Volunteer for and willingly accept assignments and complete them thoroughly and on time
- Participate in fund raising activities
- Keep up-to-date on developments in the field of dyslexia and literacy

Current Opportunities & Requirements

We are seeking experienced individuals to fill both general and specific roles on a volunteer basis.
